## Using iMovie (Ed Barkin)

Ed Barkin will demonstrate various video editing techniques using Apple's iMovie application. Many of the video editing methods, that Ed will demonstrate, may be applicable to other video editing programs.

## Working with Fonts

- Using the Font Book application to manage fonts
  - The Font Book.app is in the Applications folder.
  - Downloading fonts
  - Installing fonts

## Using *Grab* to Capture Screen or Window Images

- The Grab utility is in the Utilities folder
- On the menu bar select Capture and the type of capture
  - Selection
  - Window
  - Screen
  - Timed Screen
- The captured image will open in a window
  - To save the image select:
    - File -> Save

- The screen image will be saved as a .TIFF file
- TIFF files are rather large. If you want to attach it to an email, open the.TIFF file with preview and save it as a .JPEG file.
- The .TIFF file can be edited with an image editing program such as PhotoShop, viewed with Preview or imported into iPhoto.

## **Using *TextEdit* to work with with Microsoft Word files**

- TextEdit is in the Applications folder
- TextEdit can be used to: create, and edit Microsoft Word files

## **Drag and Drop on the Dock**

- Drag files to an application on the dock to open the application with the file
- Example: Drag an image from iPhoto to the PhotoShop icon on the dock will open PhotoShop and the image ready for editing.
