Looking Back at 2011 Facilities

- In the Lab, the 16 HP Pavilion desktops purchased in 2007 have mostly performed well and held up.
 - 2 Failed with power supply problems; one was recently revived by the Hardware Repair group.
 - We bought a new HP2055DN Laser Printer for the Lab.
- Moderate year for facility updates
 - In process of replacing the Classroom projection system with a new Epson wide-screen projector and larger screen. (purchased, but not yet installed).
 - Upgraded Hardware Repair Team's network (power line network adapters).
 - Friday maintenance sessions to keep all PCs and Macs up to date.
