## Looking Back at 2012 Facilities

- In the Lab:
  - 15 HP Pavilion p7-1370t desktops were purchased.
  - 15 new PC stands were installed.
  - A new Epson photo / slide scanner was installed.
  - A new Epson projector was installed much brighter.
  - The Friday Lab Team continues to maintain all the equipment.
- In the Classroom:
  - A new Epson wide-screen projector and larger screen were installed.
  - A HDMI switch and cables were installed to allow the Mac, the PC and various hand-held devices to share access to the new projector.
  - A new Netgear Wireless N router was installed to improve network performance.
