WHERE TO STORE THE MUSIC

CLOUD STORAGE:

Would you like to listen to your music library from anywhere? There are free online music storage sites that provide the facility to stream your music from an Android device. Music lockers as they are sometimes called are excellent for organizing and storing all your MP3s online so you can gain access to them wherever you are. Free digital music sites offer different levels of services, but all have the capability to stream your music on demand.

Music can easily be transferred from your desktop PC to Android device by any of the following:

- Digital transfer cable

- ThumbDrive

GOOGLE WALLET

- Google Wallet is a free digital wallet that securely stores your credit cards, debit cards, gift cards, loyalty cards, offers, and more. With Google Wallet, you can shop in stores, buy online, and send money.
- Google demonstrated the app at a press conference on May 26, 2011. The app was released in the United States on September 19, 2011.
- On May 15, 2013, Google announced the integration of Google Wallet and <u>Gmail</u>, allowing users to send money through Gmail attachments. Like the main service, Google Wallet's Gmail integration is also currently only available in the US.

Shop in stores:

You can shop and save in stores by storing all of your gift cards, loyalty cards and offers on the Google Wallet app. You can also purchase in stores using the Google Wallet Card or NFC tap and pay if you have an NFC-enabled Android device.

Buy Online:

You can use Google Wallet to buy on Google Play or other Google products, and on select Android apps and sites, wherever you see the Buy with Google button.

Send Money:

You can send or request money to anyone in the U.S. with an email account through Gmail or the Google Wallet app. If they don't have a Google Wallet already, they can create one in order to send and receive money.

Wallet app set up

The Google Wallet app is available to US users in the Google Play store and the Apple App Store, and works on mobile devices running Android 2.3 (Gingerbread) or higher, and iOS 6 or higher. Check out our list of <u>eligible devices</u> for more details.

If you're using Wallet for the first time:

- 1. Open the Wallet app.
- 2. Sign in with your Google Account.
- 3. Enter your 5-digit US zip code.
- 4. Touch the checkmark
- 5. Choose your email preference.
- 6. Select the option you want.
- 7. Review the terms of service.
- 8. If you agree to these terms, touch **Agree and continue** at the bottom of the screen.
- 9. Create a Wallet PIN.
- 10. Enter a new four-digit PIN. You will use this PIN to verify access to the Wallet app, and to make debit transactions and <u>cash</u> <u>withdrawals</u> using the <u>Google Wallet Card</u>.
- 11. Confirm PIN.
- 12. Re-enter your four-digit Wallet PIN.


