- The markets have recently been trading higher.
 - Dow has been in a range between 17,400 to 18,100.
 - Volatility still seems to be the norm.
- What did YOU do (if anything) in the past two months?
 - Buy on the dips? Sell (at the bottom or at the top)? Hold?
 - Did you buy Puts? Buy Calls? Sell Puts? Sell covered Calls?
 - Did you or will you buy in near the bottom?
 - Are you moving into or out of "safer" investments (bonds / CDs)
- What do YOU think will happen in the next 3-6 months?

Fundamentals Review

- Dollar remains very strong against foreign currencies.
 - Oil priced in dollars.
 - Saudis and Iran are still pumping and flooding the markets.
 - Crude oil now about \$49 and many energy stocks have risen.
 - Other commodity prices and stocks of producers still down.
- ISIS and Russians in the middle east causing great concern.
 - "Flight to quality" (Selling stocks and buying US Govt. debt) has pushed bond yields down. The 10 year Treasury note now yields about 1.61% !!!
 The 30 year Treasury note yield is 2.44% !!!
- China's economy & markets still tanking.
- Eurozone in BIG trouble due to hoards of refugees.
- Federal Reserve may raise rates .25% in June.
- Official Inflation rate is fairly low (< 2% / year)
 - Some food prices have come down (beef, pork)
 - NV Gasoline is still fairly cheap (\$2.25 at Costco)
 - Medical care & insurance is NOT cheap

 - A wallet is an app + file that allows you to manage your Bitcoin
 - A wallet runs on your computer, handheld device or the web.
- Can you use Bitcoin to make purchases?
 - Many online merchants now accept Bitcoin
 - Some brick and mortar stores also accept

Bitcoin Digital Currency (2)

Is Bitcoin "Safe"

- Relatively safe if you deal with reputable Exchange and Wallet operators.
- Governments don't like Bitcoin and so there are attempts to attack it or make it "illegal" (e.g. claim it's used for drug dealing).

Is Bitcoin a viable hedge against dollar inflation?

- Bitcoin to dollar exchange rate is somewhat volatile.
- In event of serious paper currency inflation, Bitcoin should hold value.

Should you hold Bitcoin?

- May be more trouble than it's worth.
- Similar to buying gold doesn't pay any interest.
