E-Book Document Formats

- http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Comparison_of_e-book_formats
- **E-Pub: Very widely supported**
 - Many tools that can create or convert to/from E-Pub books
 - Internal representation is XML
- **PDF: (Adobe) Widely Supported**
 - Many tools that can create PDF documents
 - Internal representation is encapsulated Postscript
 - Doesn't always reformat well to fit small screens
- **MOBIPocket: "Open E-book" standard for mobile devices**
- **HTML: All web browsers can display HTML**
 - Many tools can create HTML documents
 - HTML documents usually reformat well
- **AZW, AZW3, KF8, KFX, MOBI: Amazon Kindle formats**

- **iBooks: Apple's variation of E-Pub**

Stand-Alone E-Book Readers

- Many use e-Ink (front-lit, black and white, high contrast)
- Stand-alone e-readers often take you only to that vendor's store
- Prices coming down due to competition from tablets
- Amazon
 - Kindle White
 - Amazon Fire HD 7/8/10
- Barnes & Noble Nook
 - Glowlight
 - Nook Tablet
- Kobo Reader
 - Kobo Clara
 - Kobo Sage
- Samsung Galaxy A7
- Best to search for the *latest* models from each vendor
 - Search / shopping demo (using Google)
- Big discounts on Black Friday and other Shopping Holidays

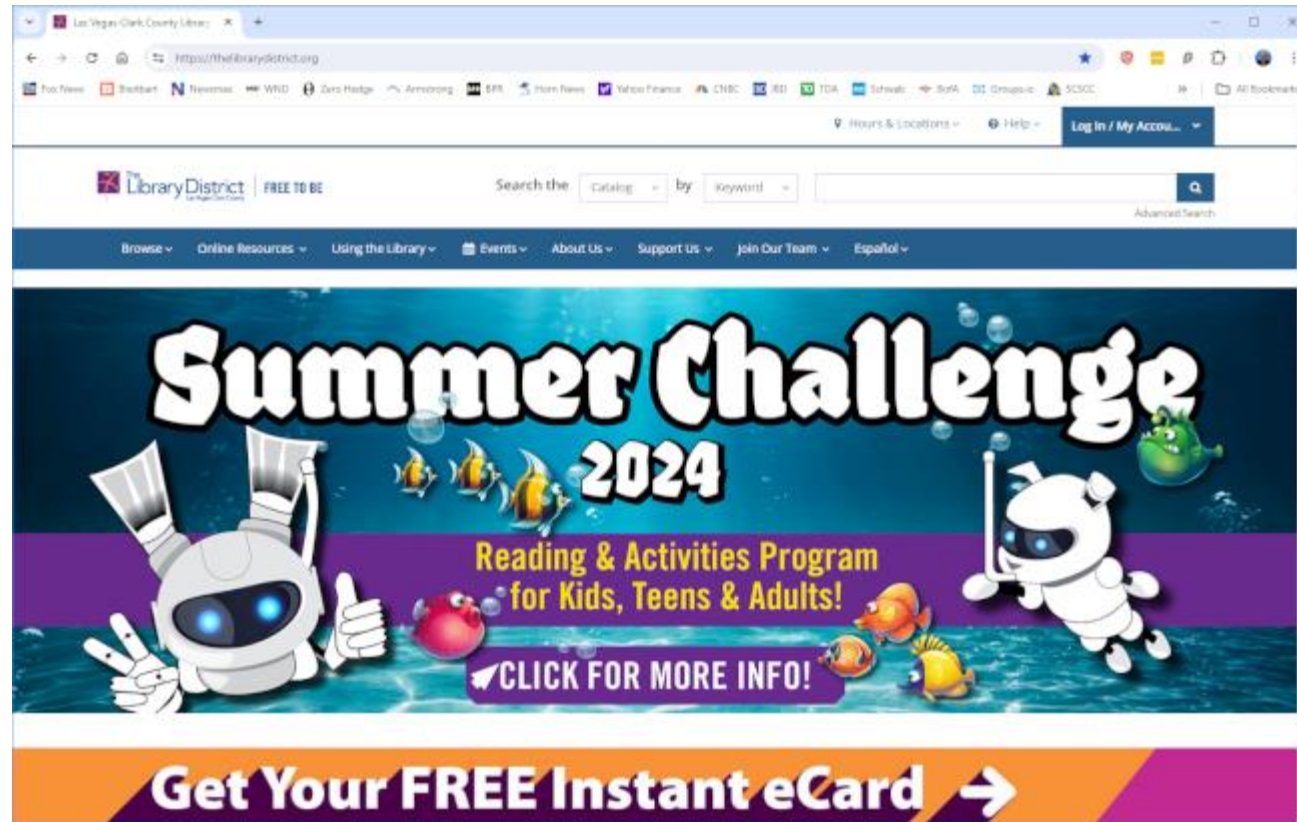

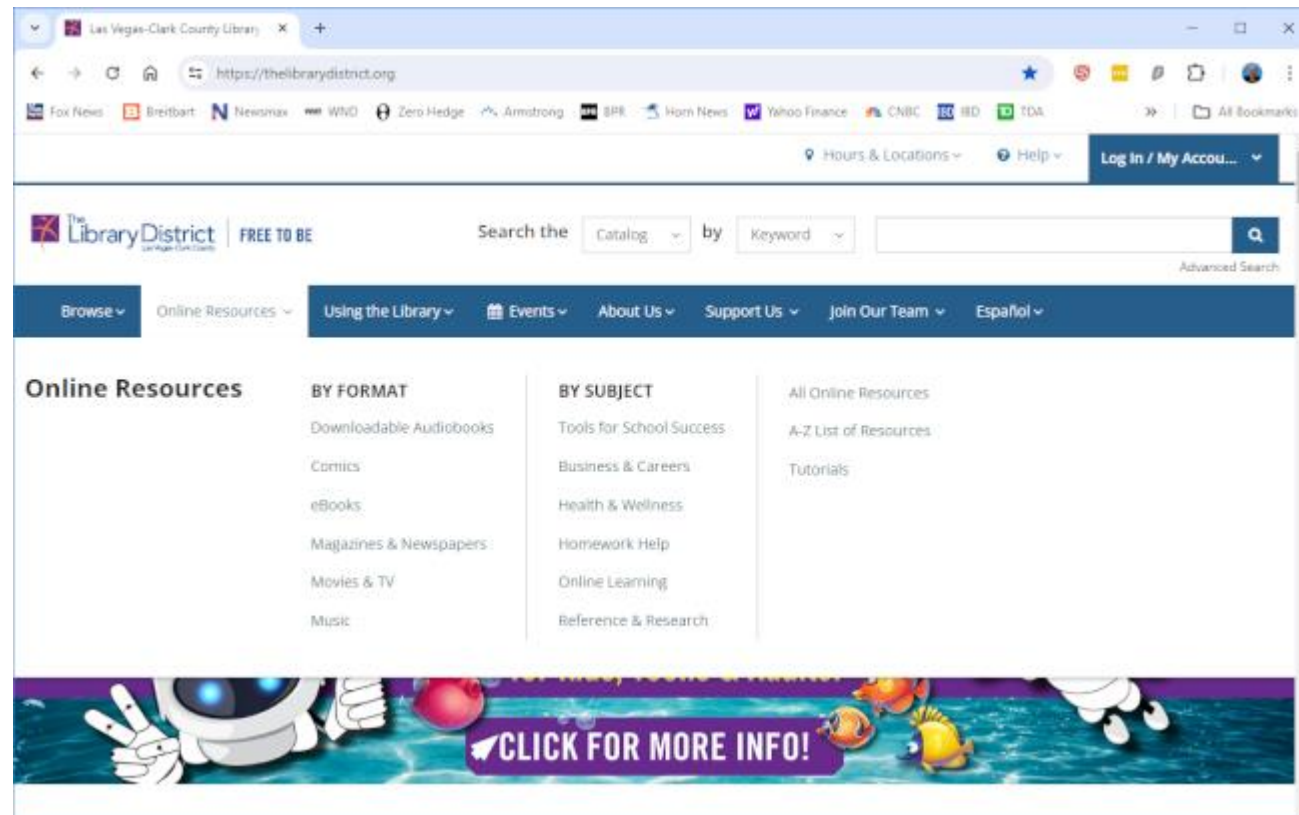


Clark County Library (2)

- Click the “Login/MyLVCCLD” button to log in.
- Enter your library card number and pin number
- Once logged in you can browse and search the collection based on various filters:
 - Author name, title, subject ,
 - E-book format
 - Type of reader
 - Availability
- If an e-book is available, you can check it out and download it.
- If currently unavailable, you can place a Hold.
 - When the book is available, you will be notified by e-mail
 - Also possible to *buy* the E-book (library gets a commission)

 - Music (Freegal) free songs you can download, up to 6 per week
 - Videos and Music (Hoopla) - Movies and videos you can check out
- **Ebooks – via OverDrive.com**

 - You can also use the Libby app on your phone or book reader
- **Online Magazines & Newspapers**
 - OverDrive magazines service included
- **Online Database Services – many available**
